Best Practices	Accessible Font Design
Simple Typeface & Distinct Letters	Avoid ornate typefaces so that letters are clear and distinct.
Familiar, Common Font	Choose a widely available or "mainstream" font that works on both PC and Mac.
Large Size	Use a minimum 12 point (16 pixels) for body text. Footers should be a minimum of 9 point (12 pixels).
Ample Spacing	Scanning long lines of text is taxing. Consistent spacing of letters, words, and line height ensures easier readability.
High Contrast & X & A & A & A & A & A & A & A & A & A	Use color palettes thoughtfully. A high contrast ratio makes your design more accessible.
